

Purpose: This one-day symposium is designed to provide a comprehensive review of echocardiography using case studies dealing with valvular heart disease, endocarditis, valve repair, peripheral arterial diseases, prosthetic valves, heart failure, tumors, embolism, trauma, dissection, adult congenital heart disease, coronary artery disease, stress, 3-dimensional, LV strain/strain rate, Doppler tissue imaging and contrast echocardiography.
